When preparing menus for our youngest customers it is our priority and responsibility to ensure the food they eat is nutritionally balanced, without undesirable additives and is freshly prepared onsite by our highly trained catering staff. As a fresh food company where all of our menu is made from raw, fresh ingredients, we only use the highest quality food produce from sustainable sources, we have freedom to choose the best suppliers ensuring all our meat, poultry, eggs and fish are from reputable sources and hold the relevant food assurance marks.

It is imperative that our menus provide students with all the necessary nutrients to give them a well-balanced meal at school lunchtimes. To promote good health, it is essential that our food offering contains sufficient energy and macronutrients. We understand that this is of utmost importance. Our 3 week primary menu cycle is adapted seasonally to ensure we are using the best, local ingredients and include a self-service salad and fruit bar, accompanied by homemade breads and fresh water.


As your schools' catering provider, it is our job to create menus each term that have tasty, nutritional meals that meet the School Food Standards. Our menus also have extra hidden nutrients and proteins in our recipes that also support with filling your child up for longer. These extra nutrients and proteins are from plant based foods that are not only nutritious, but also better for the environment.



Allergies

Your child's health and wellbeing is paramount to us, and we have a variety of safety processes to support you and your child when it comes to taking a school meal.

If you order your childs lunch via Cre8te, you can 'tick' relevant allergies when setting up your childs account. This feature will then block meal choices that have items that are not suitable for your child. You can also look at the recipes used for each of our dishes for complete peace of mind.



If you order your childs lunch via alternative platforms such as; ParentPay/Cypad, Arbour, Bromcom, or other school platforms you are required to complete the following form and return it to school as soon as possible.

We are aware that the school may already hold a lot of this information, but we feel it is important that this information is updated on a regular basis to ensure that we, as the caterer hold the correct details of your child's dietary requirements.

If your child has a variety of dietary restrictions you can arrange a meeting with the onsite catering manager or our regional operations manager to discuss your childs needs and our teams will create a menu for your child to include suitable dishes.

Free School Meals

All early years children that are in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to recieve Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM).

We think this is a fantastic initiative and we encourage all eligible pupils to take this meal, most of our schools operate an 'opt out' approach as we encourage eating schools meals from the start of the school journey. This also means that you don't need to register for this, your child is automatically entitled to it. How fantastic is that?

Not only does this save your family time and money, but you will also be giving your child a nutritionally balanced meal to fuel their minds and bodies for the rest of their school day.

UIFSM differs from Free School Meals which is an entitlement based on household income and individual parent/guardian circumstances. The government have also announced changes in the thresholds for eilgibility, meaning that more children and more households will be entitled to Free School Meals in the future.

If you feel you may be entitled to recieve Free School Meals you can request the relevant forms from your schools office or go to the government website www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals.

Sabe - Focuses on saving the planet and becoming more sustainable.


CN-50 – Focuses on teaching methods of carbon reduction.
