From 1st April 2025 we understand that the Government's transitional protection (arrangements for means tested Free School Meals (FSM) may end. Any eligible claims confirmed from this date will no longer be protected. This means any child confirmed as eligible for free school meals from I April 2025 will be subject to ongoing checks to 🔵 confirm continued eligibility. 🖉 This will not impact any children who are already confirmed as eligible.
