





Jamie Littler's (author of Arkspire) characters and books as well as taking part in an illustrating challenge.






## Recommended Reads

There's a shape up in the hills, where a giant's said to sleep, beneath a grassy blanket, on a bed of moss and peat . . .




Full of vibrant illustrations and practical ideas, this is an accessible, friendly and uplifting book of feelings.


#### LKS2- Year 3 and 4






But will Arthur and Maudie find the answers they seek?

AT JUST TWELVE YEARS OLD, ARTEMIS FOWL IS A CRIMINAL GENIUS.





Let the misadventure begin.


